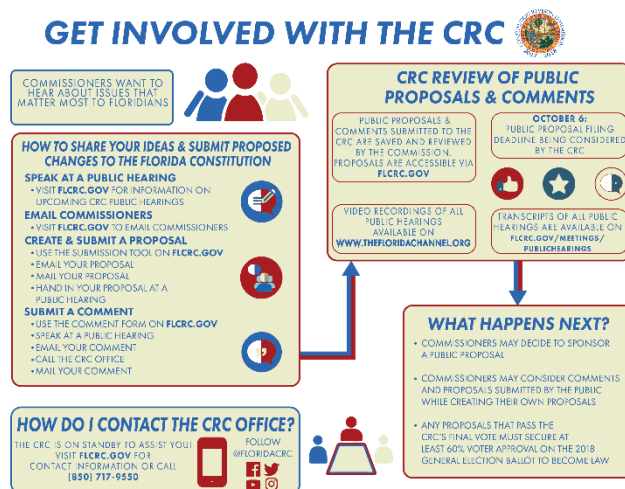

The Constitution Revision Commission, which is called the "CRC" for short, only happens once every 20 years and is a historic opportunity for all Floridians to submit proposed revisions to our state's constitution. Visit flcrc.gov and use the CRC online submission tool to share your comments, ideas and proposals.

The Constitution Revision Commission (CRC) meets only once every 20 years and is one of only five ways that the state constitution can be amended. The 2017-2018 CRC is the third of its kind in Florida history and is an opportunity for any Floridian to propose revisions to the Florida Constitution. 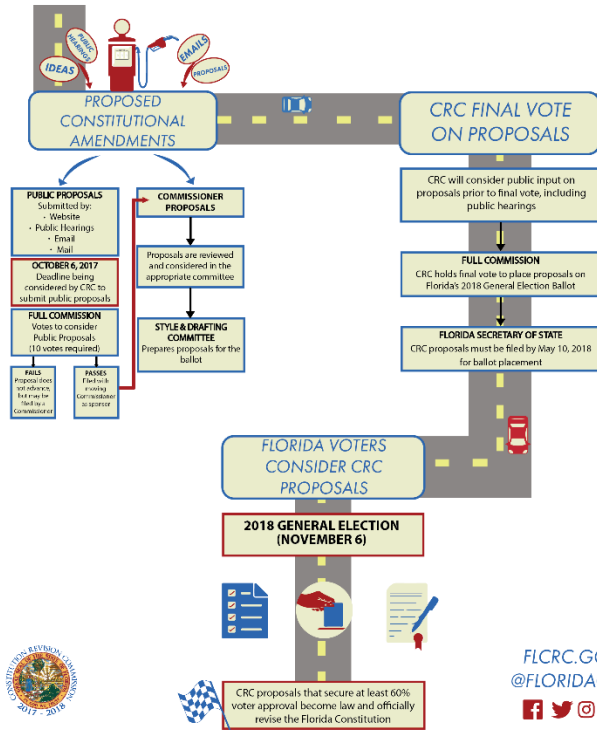
